Violin 1 & 2: Both violins play a rapid sixteenth-note pattern in the *Misterioso* section, marked *pp*. In the *Allegro Agitato* section, they play a melodic line with accents, marked *mf*.

Viola: The viola is silent in the *Misterioso* section. In the *Allegro Agitato* section, it plays a melodic line with accents, marked *f*.

Violoncello & Contrabass: Both the cello and double bass play a rhythmic pattern, marked *f*.

Double Basses: The double basses play a rhythmic pattern, marked *f*.
